Using the Digication ePortfolio to Submit Your Video Lessons

Digication is an edTPA Integrated ePortfolio Platform Provider

Digication ePortfolios

You can create and upload edTPA materials at any time but to submit the files to Pearson, you will need your Pearson Authorization Key. Your instructor will provide you with additional edTPA requirements and information.


